## PROVIDING ESSENTIALS

## HOW TO GET STARTED

Choose the type of drive you want to do and contact us. It's that simple! We can schedule drives for a couple weeks or a couple months. Printable flyers for our most popular drives are provided for your convenience. We can give you collection barrels or boxes to use during your collection. Pick up and delivery are both available options when you are ready to end your drive.



## SETTING UP YOUR DRIVE

To set up your drive we will need the following information:

- Full name/business name
- Address (include suite, apartment number, etc.)
- Phone number
- Email address
- Preferred drive start/end dates
- Type of drive (traditional or virtual)
- If you need barrels or boxes
- If you will pick up or need delivery (2 barrel minimum for delivery)
